

A vast army of restaurants, independent shops and cafe's can be found at both ends of the road; on Sloke Newington High Street and Church Street or in the other direction on Lower Clapton Road. There are lovely green spaces within valleng distance: Sloke Newington Common, Abney Park and Clissold Park. For commuters, Rectory Rd Overground Station is a 5 minute walk away and offers a 20 minute journey time to Liverpool Street.

This is a raised ground floor apartment with views of mature trees and the flat is set back from the road, making it a quiet and secluded. It has a lovely southwest facing sitting room with high ceilings, cornicing and a bay window. The room has an original fireplace, panelled walls and space for a dining table.

There are stairs leading up to a tranquil double bedroom, which is large enough for a softa and a large sash window giese views of the rear gardens. The licthen is modern and has integrated appliances and has ample counter space for food preparation. There is a large window that has lovely views and lets in lots of light. The bathroom is newly returbised with beautiful ethnic tiles, a lournious waller, in shower and heated towel radiator. The hallway has a storage cupboard, perfect for clutter free living.
